So how do we access the salvation in “Yeshua”?

- Believe
- Repent
- Be water baptized
- Be Spirit baptized
- Live holy

Believe – accept as true (act on what you know)

Believe what?

- Adam's sin instituted the death penalty
 - Gen 2:17 but of the tree of knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for I the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.
- All of us have sinned or done wrong and therefore are deserving of death
 - Rom 5:12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned

- That Yeshua is the only begotten Son of God
 - Jn 3¹⁶ For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- Yeshua paid the death penalty on our behalf, with the sacrifice of His sinless life
 - 1 Cor 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God (NIV)

- That Yeshua died for our sins, was buried, and rose again
 - 1 Cor 15: ³ For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,
 - Rom 10: ⁸ But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach): ⁹ that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Yeshua and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Repent – Feel and express regret or remorse about one's wrongdoing or sin

Lk 3: ⁷ Then he said to the multitudes that came out to be baptized by him, “Brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come? ⁸ Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance, and do not begin to say to yourselves, ‘We have Abraham as *our* father.’ For I say to you that God is able to raise up children to Abraham from these stones. ⁹ And even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.”

¹⁰ So the people asked him, saying, “What shall we do then?”

¹¹ He answered and said to them, “He who has two tunics, let him give to him who has none; and he who has food, let him do likewise.”

¹² Then tax collectors also came to be baptized, and said to him, “Teacher, what shall we do?”

¹³ And he said to them, “Collect no more than what is appointed for you.”

¹⁴ Likewise the soldiers asked him, saying, “And what shall we do?” So he said to them, “Do not intimidate anyone or accuse falsely, and be content with your wages.”

1 Cor 6: ⁹ Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

¹⁰ Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

Acts 2:38-39 Then Peter said to them, “**Repent, and** let every one of you **be baptized** in the name of Yeshua Christ for the remission of sins; **and** you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
