Why Be Baptized?

Before we answer...

1) Water Baptism – be immersed in water in the Name of Yeshua Messiah, without delay

Acts 8:<sup>36</sup> As they went along the road they came to some water; and the eunuch \*said, “Look! Water! What prevents me from being baptized?” <sup>38</sup> And he ordered that the chariot stop; and they both went down into the water, Philip as well as the eunuch, and he baptized him. <sup>39</sup> When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord snatched Philip away; and the eunuch no longer saw him, but went on his way rejoicing.



Acts 16:-<sup>29</sup> Then he called for a light, ran in, and fell down trembling before Paul and Silas. <sup>30</sup> And he brought them out and said, “Sirs, what must I do to be saved?”

<sup>31</sup> So they said, “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.” <sup>32</sup> Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all who were in his house. <sup>33</sup> And he took them the same hour of the night and washed *their* stripes. And immediately he and all his *family* were baptized.

Acts 19:1-7

2) In Yeshua's Name



Acts 2:-<sup>37</sup> Now when they heard *this*, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, “Men *and* brethren, what shall we do?”<sup>38</sup> Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Yeshua Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 19:-<sup>4</sup> Then Paul said, “John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Yeshua.”<sup>5</sup> When they heard *this*, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Yeshua.

Mt 28<sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

Acts 4: <sup>10</sup> let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Yeshua Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole.... <sup>12</sup> Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

3) It Saves Us

Mk 16<sup>16</sup> The one who has believed and has been baptized will be saved; but the one who has not believed will be condemned.

1 Pet 3: <sup>21</sup> Corresponding to that, baptism now saves you—not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience—through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,

4) Wash away sin; cancels it out; eliminates,  
erases it

Acts 2<sup>38</sup> Peter *said* to them, “Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 22:<sup>16</sup> Now why do you delay? Get up and be baptized, and wash away your sins by calling on His name.’



5) Death to old man

Rom 6:<sup>3</sup> Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? <sup>4</sup> Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too may walk in newness of life.

Not only do we need water baptism, but we need  
Spirit baptism as well

1) God wants us to have it; The Holy Spirit is for all believers

Mk 1:<sup>8</sup> I baptized you with water; but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.”

Acts 1: <sup>4</sup> Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, “Which,” *He said*, “you heard of from Me; <sup>5</sup> for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”

Acts 2:17 'And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God,  
That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons  
and your daughters shall prophesy,  
Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream  
dreams.  
<sup>18</sup> And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour  
out My Spirit in those days;  
And they shall prophesy.



## 2) Evidence of His Presence

In 3:-<sup>5</sup> Jesus answered, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. <sup>6</sup> That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. <sup>7</sup> Do not marvel that I said to you, ‘You must be born again.’ <sup>8</sup> The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit.”

Acts 2:1 When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. <sup>2</sup> And suddenly a noise like a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup> And tongues *that looked* like fire appeared to them, distributing themselves, and *a tongue* rested on each one of them. <sup>4</sup> And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with different tongues, as the Spirit was giving them *the ability* to speak out.

<sup>33</sup> Therefore, since He has been exalted at the right hand of God, and has received the promise of the Holy Spirit from the Father, He has poured out this which you both see and hear.

Acts 2:<sup>36</sup> Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ—this Jesus whom you crucified.” <sup>37</sup> Now when they heard *this*, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, Brothers, what are we to do?” <sup>38</sup> Peter *said* to them, “Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. <sup>39</sup> For the promise is for you and your children and for all who are far away, as many as the Lord our God will call to Himself.”

Acts 10: <sup>44</sup> While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word. <sup>45</sup> And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. <sup>46</sup> For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God.

Acts 19: <sup>5</sup> When they heard *this*, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. <sup>6</sup> And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied. <sup>7</sup> Now the men were about twelve in all.
