1) According to Jn 4:24, what two things are needed to worship God properly?

2) Which one did King David lack when he began moving the ark to Jerusalem in 1 Chron 13?

3) Which scripture most closely relates to the two things in the answer of question #1?

- 1 Jn 3:18 My little children, let us not **love in word**, neither **in tongue**; but **in deed and in truth**.
- Is 1:19 If you are **willing and obedient**, You shall eat the good of the land;

... **What *is* His name**, and **what *is* His Son's name**, If you know? (Prov 30:4)

According to biblical expert Nehemiah Gordon, the proper name of God was written more than 6800 times in the original bible manuscripts.

Scribes and bible translators removed it with the explanation that it was too holy to speak, and substituted it with the title "LORD".

LORD all caps = personal name of God

Joel 2:32 And it shall come to pass *That* whoever **calls** on the **name** of the LORD Shall be **saved**. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, As the LORD has said, Among the remnant whom the LORD **calls**.

Prov 18:10 The **name** of the LORD *is* a **strong tower**; The righteous run to it and are safe.

Ps 91:14 “Because he has set his **love** upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My **name**.

Father's name is "Yehovah" – self existent one; a contraction of hayah, hoveh, yihyeh

- Hayah – He was
- Hoveh – He is
- Yihyeh – He will be forever
- Yah – poetic form



Behold, God is my salvation: I will trust, and not be afraid; for Jah, Jehovah, is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation. (Is 12:2) Darby, YLT

- English – “J” instead of “y”
- Yahweh popular
- **Yah**weh is like saying “tophill” instead of “hilltop”; “ballfoot” instead of “football”; “bowrain” instead of “rainbow”.

1. **Yehoshua** -YHVH saves- **Yesha**yahu****
2. **Yehonatan** -YHVH has given- **Netan**yahu****
3. **Yehotzadak** -YHVH is righteous- **Tzidki**yahu****
4. **Yehoachaz.** -YHVH has grasped/possessed- **Achaz**yahu****
5. **Yehozabad.** -YHVH has endowed/given- **Zebad**yah****
6. **Hallelu**jah**** - (“j” for “y”)

The **Son's** name – Yeshua/ Yehoshua – Yehovah is salvation

- Greek – “Iesous”
- no “y”; no “sh” sound; and masculine ending “s”
- Latin – “Iesus”
- English – “Jesus”



As we said in the beginning of this lesson, one of the reasons it is important to know God and the Son's name is because it is how we access salvation.

Behold, God is my salvation: I will trust, and not be afraid; for Jah, Jehovah, is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation. (Is 12:2) Darby, YLT

- Salvation – 3444 **yeshuah: Salvation, deliverance, victory**
- **Yehovah is become my Yeshua**

So how do we access the salvation from “Yeshua”?

- Believe
- Repent
- Be water baptized
- Be Spirit baptized
- Live holy

Believe – accept as true (act on what you know)

Believe what?

- Adam's sin instituted the death penalty
  - Gen 2:17 but of the tree of knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for I the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.
- All of us have sinned or done wrong and therefore are deserving of death
  - Rom 5:12 Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned

- That Yeshua is the only begotten Son of God
  - Jn 3<sup>16</sup> For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- Yeshua paid the death penalty on our behalf, with the sacrifice of His sinless life
  - 1 Cor 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God (NIV)
- That Yeshua died for our sins, was buried, and rose again
  - 1 Cor 15: <sup>3</sup> For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

Repent – Feel and express regret or remorse about one's wrongdoing or sin

Lk 3: <sup>7</sup> Then he said to the multitudes that came out to be baptized by him, “Brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come? <sup>8</sup> Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance, and do not begin to say to yourselves, ‘We have Abraham as *our* father.’ For I say to you that God is able to raise up children to Abraham from these stones. <sup>9</sup> And even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.”



<sup>10</sup> So the people asked him, saying, “What shall we do then?”

<sup>11</sup> He answered and said to them, “He who has two tunics, let him give to him who has none; and he who has food, let him do likewise.”

<sup>12</sup> Then tax collectors also came to be baptized, and said to him, “Teacher, what shall we do?”

<sup>13</sup> And he said to them, “Collect no more than what is appointed for you.”

<sup>14</sup> Likewise the soldiers asked him, saying, “And what shall we do?” So he said to them, “Do not intimidate anyone or accuse falsely, and be content with your wages.”



Acts 2:38-39 Then Peter said to them, “**Repent, and** let every one of you **be baptized** in the name of Yeshua Christ for the remission of sins; **and** you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
